Approval of Minutes: The March 12, 2014 minutes were approved as presented.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>: The agenda was approved with the change to move the Rules & Procedures Committee report to the after the 'Approval of Agenda'.

Guest Speakers:

Kyle Wray, VP Enrollment Management/Marketing, updated the Council that this year has had record numbers of attendees for campus visits/tours/main events. There have been about 11,500 applications for the 2014-15 academic year. The LASSO program and new student orientation have been combined and Missy Wikle is the Director. Financial Aid Director, Charlie Bruce, will be retiring June 30. 'America's Brightest Orange' will probably remain the OSU marketing campaign as it facilitates promoting various aspects of OSU including outstanding students and faculty. OSU will be marking/celebrating the 100th anniversary of The Smith-Lever Act of 1914 which established the cooperative extension services at land grant universities. VP Wray also discussed the importance of the licensing/trademark area and using only the approved OSU logos. The funds received from the sale of licensed items help the whole institution not just athletics.




